SUBJECT INFORMATION: Unknown

EVENT DESCRIPTION: An unknown individual(s) entered a student apartment in the University Village sometime between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. yesterday, while no one was present. Once inside, the unknown person(s) took electronic equipment and left the apartment sometime shortly afterward. Though unconfirmed, it remains likely the unknown person(s) entered through an apartment window that was left unlocked.

<u>UMPD</u> has stepped up patrol in the area and police are actively investigating the incident at this time.

Prevention Tips:

- Be sure to lock all doors and secure all entryways into your residence.
- If you come home and discover a break-in may have occurred, do not enter the residence -- the
 perpetrator may still be inside. Call police right away and wait in a safe place.
- Be conscious of your surroundings. If you notice any suspicious activity, get to a place of safety and call
 police or notify security immediately.
